## IS WORKING WITH THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT COVID-19 MANDATES

Working within the State of Connecticut guidelines and the correlating mandates regarding COVID-19, our classes will be adjusted accordingly to accommodate as many students as safely possible. If you or your child doesn't feel comfortable coming back to physical classes just yet, you can participate by registering for our classes on Zoom. Your child's physical class and the Zoom class will be held simultaneously. Currently, this is our solution for those that do not feel ready to participate physically. When you are ready and feel comfortable, you can physically join your peers in class to continue your instruction.

Due to direct physical contact restrictions, physical gymnastics classes will be put on hold until January (or hopefully sooner). We can still register you for the gymnastics class to reserve your spot, however those classes are set to resume in January.

Please complete and return our 2020-21 Registration Form as soon as possible. We are accepting registrations on a first come basis.

### Our Guidelines:

- Class size will be adjusted according to the state mandates for social distancing.
- The door to our studio will be locked from the outside until right before class time to eliminate congregating in a tight space. It will be very important for students to arrive promptly for their class time.
- Everyone must wear proper facial coverings (ie: Masks); they will need to cover the nose AND the mouth.
- Temperatures (forehead scans) will be taken upon arrival. If the student has no temperature, they will be allowed to participate.
- Everyone will sanitize their hands upon entering the studio.
- Only dance shoes should be brought into the studio; No dance bags
- Students will have their 6 ft. dance space, with 6 ft. distance around them.
- Upon exiting the studio, students will sanitize their hands again.
- Scheduling will accommodate 15 minute blocks of time in between classes to sanitize the dance areas.
- Parents must be prompt in picking up students; the waiting room has been temporarily closed so as to abide by not congregating in tight areas.
